The music starts to brew at 11 am at Beans and Leaves Coffee & Tea Cafe and winds up post- midnight with headliner Eddie Taylor Jr. Blues Band (9:30 pm – midnight) at the Village Tavern. Eddie Taylor Jr. Blues Band - 9:30 pm – 12:30 am. at The Village Tavern. One of Chicago's noted blues musicians, Eddie Taylor Jr. was born into his profession. The sixth child of legendary blues guitarist and namesake Eddie Taylor, the young Taylor learned from a master and has gone on to earn his own reputation as a bold and energetic player in the traditional Chicago blues style. His first release was the well-received "Lookin' for Trouble" on Wolf Records.
